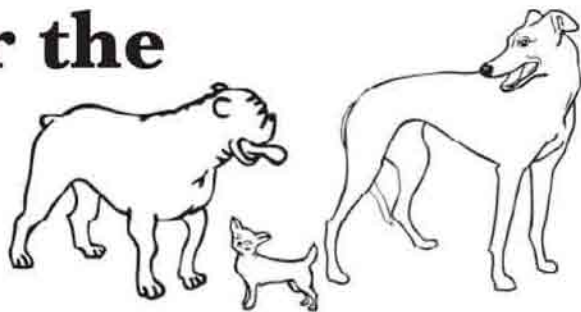


# For the Dogs!



Dogs can be such wonderful friends. They don't ask for much--good food exercise, a little attention, and someone to look after their health. Dogs shouldn't be fed the uncooked meat of diseased animals. Dogs shouldn't be kept in small cages all day. And dogs shouldn't be given dangerous anabolic steroids. But that is how hundreds of dogs in South Tucson are treated!

It's time for the dogs to be treated better! That is what the Tucson Dog Protection Act will do. This November we are asking voters to approve three rules:

- 1. No person shall knowingly feed a dog uncooked meat from diseased, dying, or disabled animals or animals dead upon arrival at the slaughterhouse.**
- 2. No person shall give anabolic steroids to any dog to to artificially enhance performance or to prevent a dog from going into heat.**
- 3. No person shall confine a dog to a crate or cage for more than a total of 18 hours unless such confinement is deemed medically necessary by a veterinarian.**
